

**Pop-Up
Snowflake Card**

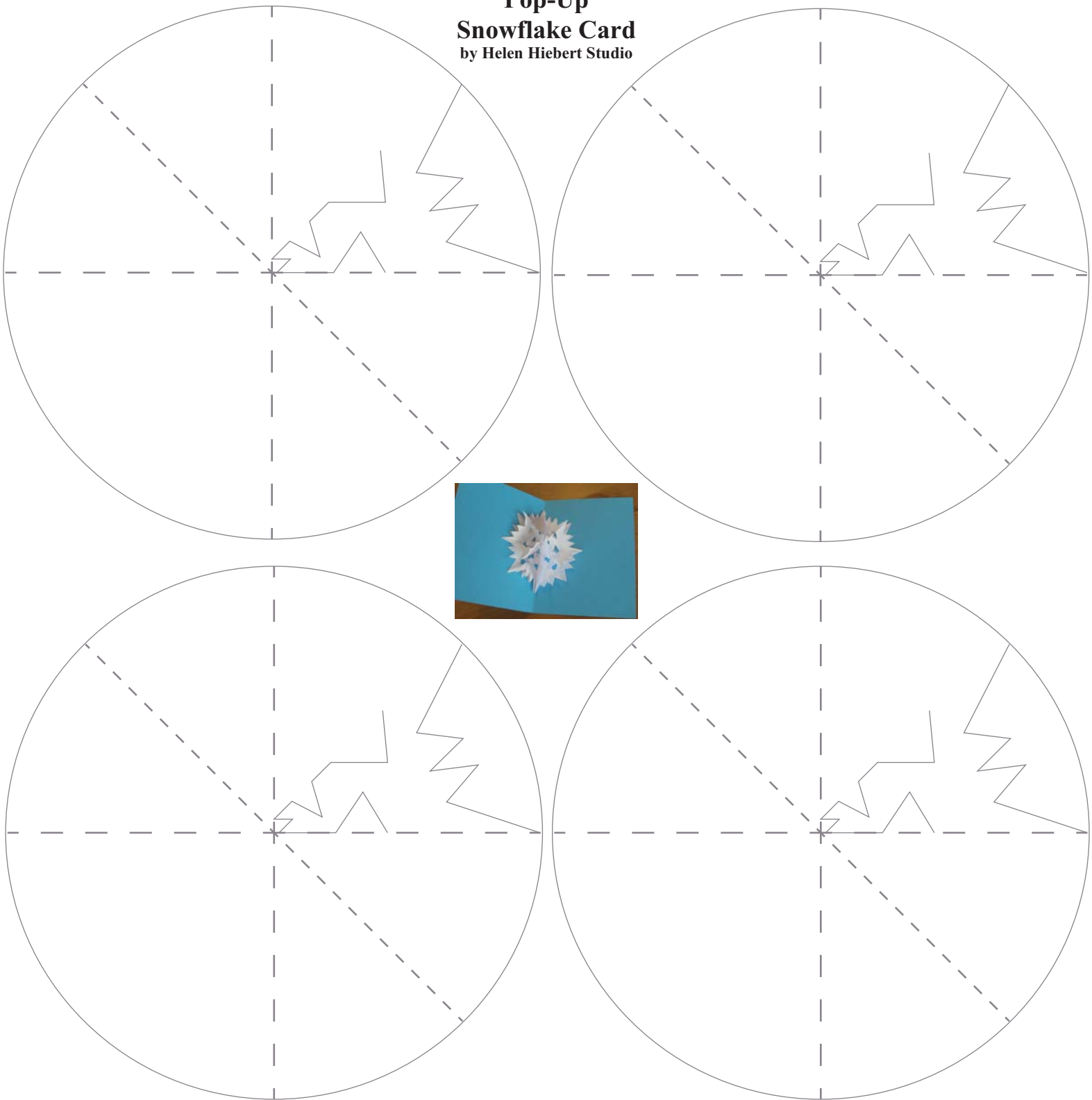

1. Cut out the four white circles. 2. Fold each circle in half along one of the heavy dashed lines and crease the fold. Unfold and flatten. Don't turn the paper over. Fold the circle in half again, on the other heavy dashed line. Now turn the paper over and fold the circle in half along the lighter dashed line so that the end points of the two previous folds meet and overlap. Unfold keeping the last fold face up (a mountain fold) and push down on the center where all of the folds intersect. Let the creases guide you in folding a quarter circle, making sure that the printed areas remain on the outside. Fold in half once again. 3. Cut along the lines through all layers, removing the paper bits. Unfold once to create a 1/4 circle (see Figure 1). 4. Fold the blue base sheet in half to create a card that measures 8-1/2" x 5-1/2". 5. Apply glue to the outer layer of each snowflake quarter and stick two petal pieces on either side of the centerfold (See Fig 2). 6. Carefully apply glue to the center circle formed by the joined petals and close the card so that they stick to each other. Carefully open the card.
