

I've put together a kit by ordering in bulk that includes almost all of the materials you'll need to make the projects. If you have these materials on hand, great – I love seeing the variations people come up with. You are welcome to source these materials yourself. My goal is to make this simple and affordable for you!

In most cases, you will receive enough paper to create at least two of each project.

The kit price is \$75.

INCLUDED IN THE KIT:**1. Strip Books**

- (10) assorted 8-1/2 x 11" sheets in the 65# cover weight Pop Tone line from French Paper Co.
- (20) assorted brads from Eyelet Outlet.com
- 1/4", 3/8" and 1/2" screw posts from [Binding 101](#)

2. Criss Cross Structure

- (8) assorted 8-1/2 x 11" sheets in the 80# cover weight Construction line from French Paper Co.

3. Envelope Forms

- (8) assorted A6 (4-3/4 x 6-1/2") envelopes from French Paper Co.
- (2) 7" x 9" sheets of a translucent decorative paper
- 5 bamboo skewers

4. Inflatable Ball

- (3) sheets of 9" x 12" tracing paper or equivalent on a roll
- (10) sheets of 6" x 6" kite paper from Amazon

5. Woven Paper Notebook

- (3) assorted colors, 6" x 11" of Japanese momi washi paper from Mulberry Paper & More
- 2 bamboo skewers
- plastic cutting mat material
- Map or other decorative paper from a Pepin Book

6. Shadow Lantern

- For one shadow lantern you will need (3) 1/4" x 1/4" x 36" balsa sticks from Specialized Balsa
- (2) 8-1/2" x 11" in the 80# cover weight Construction line from French Paper Co.
- (2) 8-1/2" x 11" sheets of another translucent paper

7. Template Pages printed on 8-1/2 x 11" paper (these will be available online as well)

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES you will need that are not included in the kit:

- White Glue/PVA
- Repositionable tape (painter's or artist's tape) for holding things in place

TOOLS:

- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Bone folder
- Awl
- Needle & Thread
- Cutting mat
- Craft knife
- Eraser
- Small glue brush (1/4" children's or artist's paintbrush)
- Japanese screw punch (from Talas or Michaels)

Optional but helpful tools & materials:

- Double-sided tape (1/4" or 1/2")
- Metal triangle
- [Small hand saw & mitre box](#) for cutting balsa wood (from Amazon or Specialized Balsa)
- Hole punches
- Deckled edge scissors
- Rubber stamps & ink
- Drawing & mark making tools
- Sewing machine
- Cricut portable paper trimmer
- Long arm stapler
